## **Galatians** **A People Freed from Sin**

**Text:** Galatians 3:23-29

**Purpose:** Paul's main argument was that the Promise of Abraham and the Mosaic Law go together. The law has its purpose to reveal our need for Jesus and the faith we have in Jesus makes us more than just being out from under the law, but children of God.

**Opening Question:** *Looking back, what time of your life is the most nostalgic?*

**Read and Discuss:** Galatians 3:23-29

1. *How does Paul describe the Law?*
2. *If we are no longer under the law, then what's the purpose of the law? How does the law drive us toward Jesus?*
3. *How are you like your parents? What does it look like to be a son or daughter of God?*
4. *How does our identity shape our habits? How does knowing who you are in Christ lead us to live the law?*
5. *What does the law teach us about other people? How does the law connect us? Since we all need to be rescued, how does that lead our empathy toward one another?*
6. *What does it mean to be an heir of Jesus? What hope does that give us for today?*
