Series Title: Missionally Engaged: A Matter of the Heart

Throughout this series, we've explored the book of Jonah and discussed its themes as a means of understanding our own heart and motivations. How do we see others? How might God want to use us to reach others with his message of redemption? This week we are tying it all together by asking the question "What does it mean for us to be missionally engaged where we live, work, and play?"

Read 2 Corinthians 5:16-21 & Discuss

1. What does it mean to be "missionally engaged" (or as Paul describes in 2 Corinthians 5:20 "ambassador for Christ")?
2. Where do you find it easiest—and hardest—to be missionally engaged in your daily life (home, work, neighborhood, etc.)? Why do you think that is?
3. Think about someone in your life who feels like your "Nineveh"—someone hard to love, engage, or forgive. How might God be inviting you to see them through His eyes?
4. Comfort, fear, or busyness often keep us from stepping into God's mission. Which of these do you wrestle with most? What might it look like to take one small step of obedience this week?
5. What would change in your neighborhood, workplace, or circle of friends if you fully embraced your role as a witness of God's love? What's one thing you can do this week or this summer to live that out?
