- 4. What does Nehemiah do in verse 7 with his anger? What strategies help you to think about another person's point of view?
- 5. How does Nehemiah deal with his anger in verse 7-9? Why is dialogue so difficult in our culture today? What does healthy dialogue on different views look like?
- 6. What does Nehemiah's example look like in verses 9-12?
- 7. In our circle of influence, how can we help to unite people who differ on cultural issues?
