4. When do you realize something in your life has become an idol and has replaced God? What are some of the warning signs?

5. How do idols rob us of God's joy?

Read and Discuss: 1 Kings 18:22-29

6. Why are false gods so easy to worship and serve? What makes them attractive?

7. What are some possible idols/false gods that you wrestle with? What are some ways that you can remember their insignificance and God's significance?
