The Church the World Needs - Week 5 Acts 6-8: Witness Works Outward

Text: Acts 6:8 - 8:3

Purpose: As Christians, we are called to be bold and faithful witnesses of Jesus in the midst of an ever-changing world and landscape. How do we do that well as a church and as individuals? Not through our own abilities, but through the faithfulness of Jesus.

Opening Interaction: How do you respond to change? Do you naturally embrace it or do you hate it? Describe a time when you experienced change.

Read and Discuss: Acts 6:8-15; 7:54 - 8:3

- In this passage, what details seem important? What jumps out at you?
- What is the author communicating to his audience?
- What does this passage teach us about God?
- 1. How can we encourage one another to be in God's Word and know his story well?
- 2. What makes being misunderstood so difficult?
- 3. Do you naturally embrace changes in the church (see them as a way to trust God in new ways) or do you resist change? How can we help one another to trust God during new seasons of life and ministry?
- 4. Read Philippians 3:8-11. What is Paul saying here? What can we do with this passage?
