Jesus Unexpected--Women

Text: Genesis 1:27-31; Genesis 3:14-19; Luke 8:1-3

Purpose: One of the most unexpected aspects of Jesus' ministry was how He viewed and treated women. The Bible gives us a healthy blueprint for how to view men and women despite our culture context.

Opening Question: Who would you vote for Man of the Year and Woman of the Year 2019?

Read and Discuss: Genesis 1:27-31; Genesis 3:14-19; Luke 8:1-3

- 1. What does it mean that man and woman were both created in "the image of God"?
- 2. The Hebrew word to describe Eve was "helper", the word to describe Adam as male was "impact". What do these two descriptions have in common? How do they compliment each other?
- 3. How does the Fall change the unity between men and women?
- 4. How has the Fall impacted the relationship between men and women today?
- 5. How did Jesus interact and view women differently than his culture (Lk 8:1-3)?
- 6. How are men called to view women in the Bible? How are women called to view men in the Bible?
